NZISA dismisses Secretary from National Executive

Interim Secretary shall carry on with the responsibilities and duties of the outgoing Secretary.

On 28th August 2018, the International Students' Association ("NZISA") has moved a motion to remove its current Secretary from the National Executive, on recommendation of the Representative Council under Clause 8.3.5 of the Association's Constitution. We regret to announce that the motion was passed.

This decision was an extremely difficult one to make and NZISA has taken careful steps to consider this matter.

An interim National Secretary has been appointed to take over the responsibilities and duties of the outgoing secretary. Measures have been taken to ensure that no disruptions will arise on the operations of NZISA following this decision.

NZISA will be holding its Annual General Meeting (AGM) on the 8th September, during its inaugural Conference.
